## **Medicare Part D Drug Plan Search Instructions**

## Step by step instructions:

- 1. Go to <a href="www.medicare.gov">www.medicare.gov</a>. It's recommended that you create an account, so you can store your information for the future.
- 2. Under "Find Health & Drug Plans," click "Find Plans Now."
- 3. Enter Zip Code, then click "Continue."
- 4. Select "Medicare drug plan (Part D)," then "Find Plans."
- 5. Select "I don't get help from any of these programs," then click "Continue."
- 6. The next page will say, "Do you want to see your drug costs when you compare plans?" Select "Yes," then click "Next."
- 7. Add your drug list by entering the name of the drug, correct dosage, quantity, and frequency.
- 8. After building your drug list, click "Done Adding Drugs."
- 9. Choose your pharmacy and click "Continue to View Plans" on the lower-right.
- 10. Medicare will now show the drug plan options, and you can sort (upper right) by "Lowest drug + premium cost". The first plan listed will result in the lowest prescription costs for you in 2026. You can compare multiple plans.
- 11. For each option, click "Plan Details" to see what you'll pay for each of your prescriptions at your preferred pharmacy.
- 12. Most choose the lowest cost option, so you will likely want to click "Enroll" for that plan and continue through the application.
